- One entry per household is allowed.



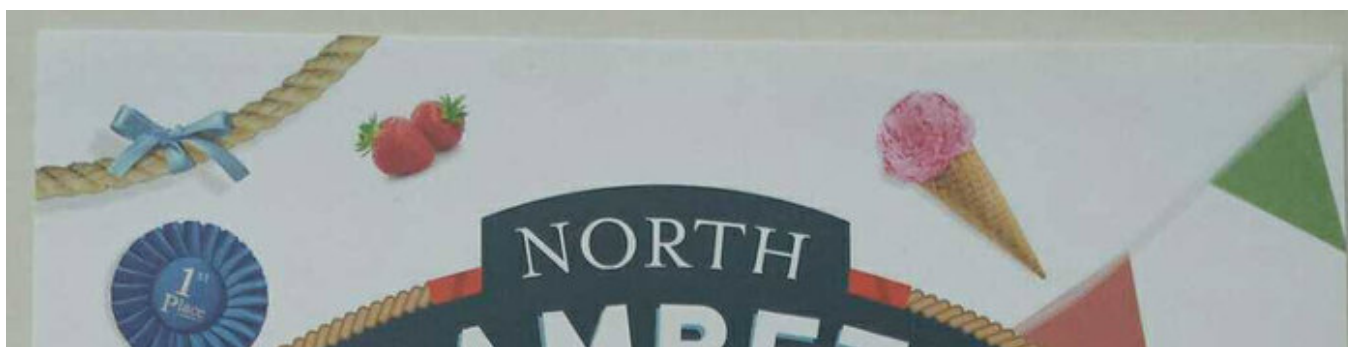
Vauxhall Park summer fair

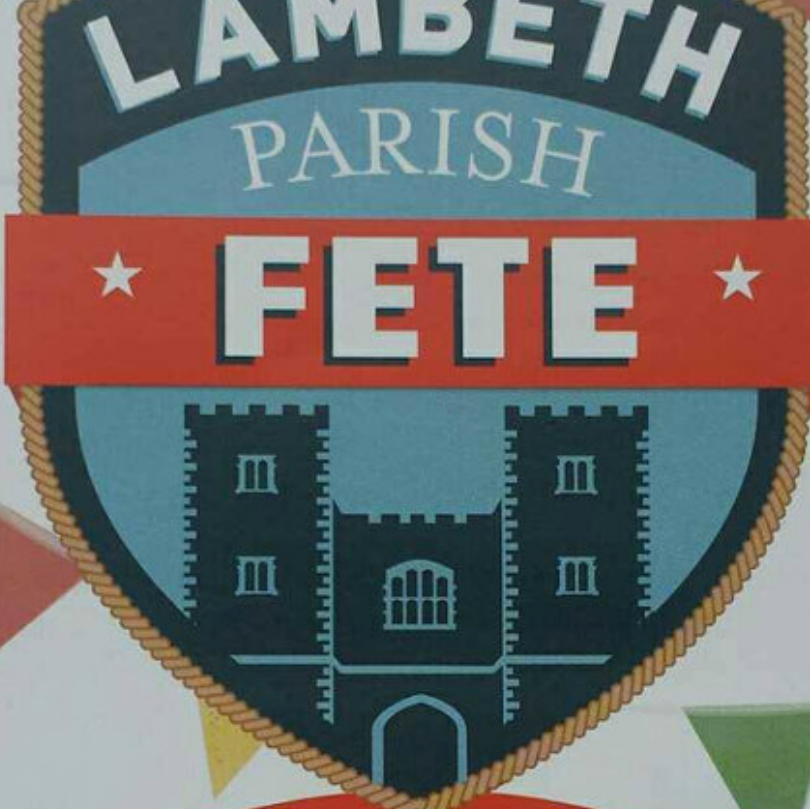

Lambeth Walk Consultation - ends 19th June

The London Borough of Lambeth, the Council, intend to grant a lease for a term of up to 25 years of a parcel of land at Lambeth Walk Public Open Space in Kennington to the Kennington Association Ltd. The land will be added to Lollard Street Adventure Playground and used for the development of changing rooms to enable better use of the Adventure Playground Sports Pitches.
