

Neighbourhood Plan Referendum To Go Ahead!



After many years of consultation and hard work by the community, the Government Examiner and Lambeth Council have agreed that an official local referendum should be held to adopt the Kennington, Oval, and Vauxhall Neighbourhood Plan.

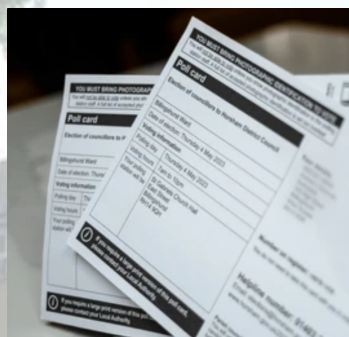
When will this happen?

Polling cards will be sent out by Lambeth in early November, enabling the Referendum to take place on **Thursday, 11th December 2025**.

You will vote in the same place as in a normal election (check your polling card).

You can also apply for a postal vote – new laws mean this is no longer a permanent arrangement, so you **MUST** renew this if you haven't done so already at:
