Details: 16/00908/FUL Extensions to the existing office building at ground and first floor to provide additional office (Use Class B1) and associated ancillary accommodation, the introduction of new accessible (in part) roof terraces at second and roof floor levels, creation of additional opening to create access to existing eleventh floor terrace (door), creation of openings (windows and door) on the twelfth floor, plus associated landscaping works, including hard and soft landscaping, a widened riverside walk and all associated works.

### **One Nine Elms - update**

Monday 22nd – Friday 26th February

- Removal of waste materials and concrete away from the site.
- Trial pits will be dug for investigation works to be carried on the

existing drain that runs on the site.

- Additional site investigation works.
- Probing and surveying of existing pile locations will continue.
- Installation of sheet piles, coring of existing piles and formation of new bearing piles will take place throughout the week.

On the morning of Monday 22nd February a new piling rig will be delivered to the site.

### **Parks gate locking service 2016**

The Culture 2020 cabinet report in October 2015 approved a number of changes to the councils parks service, including a reduction in the number of parks which are locked overnight.

The parks night locking service currently costs the council over £100,000 per year and in order to reduce these costs, it is planned to withdraw overnight locking at the following parks by April 2016:

Agnes Riley Gardens

Elam Street Park

Hillside Gardens

Old Paradise gardens

Palace Road.

Windmill Gardens.

Holmewood Gardens

Grafton Square

Milkwood Road Community Park

Slade Gardens

Pedlars Park.

Streatham Vale Park.
