

From Sunday 29 May 2016 for around 10 weeks, roads around Vauxhall will be busier than usual while surveying work takes place. Please see link below for full details:





Tuesday 31st May - Friday 3rd June

Coring of existing piles, formation of new bearing piles and installation of plunge columns will continue to take place throughout the week.

Piling works for the new diaphragm wall will be carried out.

Hydro demolition works to the remaining section of raft slap.

The existing cased piles will be removed.

Additional monitoring stations will be set up across the site.

The overpumping equipment on site will be relocated.

The working hours for the next week are:

Saturday: 0800-1300

Sunday and Monday: No works

Tuesday-Friday: 0800-1800

Wandsworth Council have granted permission for piling works to continue outside of normal hours until 11pm during the week when necessary. Any works taking place after 6pm will only be concreting operations and will not involve the noisy coring of piles.
