Garden Museum Cafe survey

The Garden Museum has closed for a £7.5 million re-development and will re-open in early 2017. The project will create six new galleries inside the ancient church, restore its

interior, construct two new education rooms, improve visitor facilities and generate a new bigger brighter café (with twice as many seats), wrapped around a garden extended to the design of Dan Pearson. The new café will have independent access from Lambeth Road. This major investment is an opportunity to extend our current catering offer. Darley house artwork '*Relief of Mother and Children Playing* by Peter Laszlo Peri, 1951-52' recognised! Hungarian Peri was largely ignored by the 20th Century British art establishment, which some have attributed to his communist leanings. These three works were commissioned in the austerity years after WW2 on our estate as a poignant dedication to children who lost their lives in the Blitz.
