**Carron House**

David Boardman, KOV Forum Chair of Planning took part in a walkabout with the Lambeth Conservation Officer to review an application for Carron House. KOV Forum are pleased the Planning Committee agreed with the Conservation Officer and the forum that the proposals presented were unsuitable on this development.

### **Conservation Area consultations**

As previously reported consultation has now closed. However a number of Board members from the KOV Forum took part in a walkabout with Lambeth's Conservation Officer to review the proposals. In addition, the KOV Forum has endeavoured to contact relevant landowners and discuss views. In the next newsletter after Easter, KOV will publish the representation it is making on this.



### **Remember Vauxhall View?**

In the 1990s, Lambeth Council was in need of a major shake-up and a key player in the process was the Vauxhall View. It was a monthly magazine which first appeared in 1993 and ran for 33 issues until 1998. During that time it was very influential, soon extending its coverage to Brixton issues. It encouraged an interest in planning issues and in local history. The publisher and editor was Steve Morse, who ran the magazine on a shoestring budget from his flat, with the help of a small unpaid team. 9th January was the 10th anniversary of his death and a memorial event is being planned for later this year. 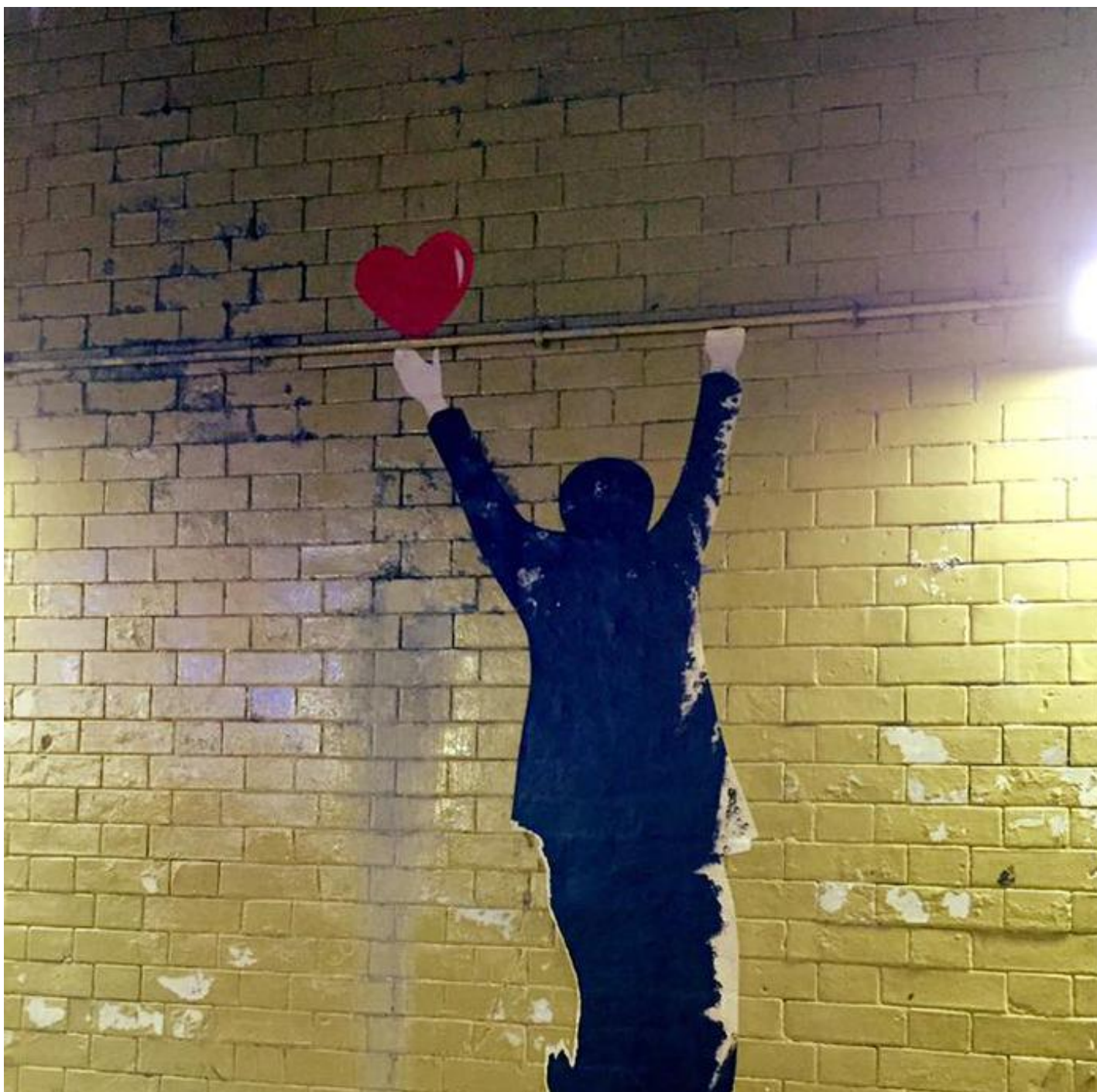
